WHO WE ARE?

Central Reptile Rehome Network was setup to assist independent reptile rescues to communicate with one another, helping in situations of overcrowding or emergencies.

As the network developed we found the issue with independent, home run rescues were subject to trust issues and welfare issues from the public and reptile community.

This is where the network dynamic shifted, by recognising the lack of regulation within rescues.

WHAT WE DO?

The CRRN is here to bridge the gaps, serving as a platform to bring trust, honesty, transparency and responsibility to independent reptile rescues

By applying self regulation via policies, welfare benchmarks and welfare checks that rescues agree to when signing up, we can then promote these rescues as reputable and trusted.

WHAT WE ASK OF YOU?

As a CRRN member we ask that you are open, honest, responsible and transparent. This works in favour with the reptile community and the public to bring trust.

To work within our policies that are designed to improve rescues and welfare, in a self regulated way rather than authoritative (regulations and licensing will come as this sector evolves).

To allow us to conduct welfare monitoring that puts us in a position to promote you as trusted.

To use the tooling provided that helps you, helps the network and the overall hobby.

To pay a £4 per month membership (a cup of coffee a month!)

WHAT DOES YOUR £4 DO?

1. Firstly it makes you invested into a growing network and it's overall mission.

2. Allows you to access tooling put in place to help you communicate with other rescues this makes you part of a community of like minded, welfare first people.

3. Allows access to tooling to manage intake capacity, manage species taken in and help collect data that helps the wider reptile community. (CRRN hub app /Google sheets)

4. Access to guidance, support and education resources to help run your rescue responsibly. (Care guides, social media guidance, vet/emergency guidance/templates and much more)

5. Makes you a responsible, welfare led rescue by agreeing to our welfare checks and policies. This is a significant part of the network as this section of the reptile hobby evolves, it allows us to promote your rescue as honest and trusted.

6. Exposure on our socials, website and in our resources.

7. Support Responsible Reptile Keeping (RRK)

8. Current and ongoing exclusive member discounts to save money wherever possible.

9. Sets you apart from scammers/flippers and profiteers who have exposed rescuing reptiles making it harder for genuine rescues to promote credibility.

10. Along with future donations/grants, your £4 could also go to assisting rescues with emergencies, urgent vet care and projects that help reptile welfare.
